

**AN ACT TO *AMEND* § 3602(b)(1) OF ARTICLE 6,  
CHAPTER 3, TITLE 16, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED;  
AND *ADD* A NEW § 26203(k)(37) TO ARTICLE 2 OF  
CHAPTER 26, TITLE 11, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED,  
RELATIVE TO EXEMPTING THE OFFICIAL VEHICLE  
INSPECTION SAFETY (OVIS) FEES COLLECTED BY  
VEHICLE SAFETY INSPECTION STATIONS ON  
BEHALF OF THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM FROM  
BEING APPLIED TO GROSS INCOME FOR THE  
PURPOSE OF ASSESSING AND COLLECTING  
BUSINESS PRIVILEGE TAXES.**

1           **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2           **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds  
3 that vehicle safety inspection stations are assigned the duty of collecting, on behalf  
4 of the government of Guam, the Official Vehicle Inspection Safety (OVIS) Fee,  
5 which is part of the vehicle safety inspection fee charged and set by law for the  
6 registration of every vehicle.

7           *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that vehicle safety inspection stations pay  
8 business privilege taxes on these fees, which are remitted to the government of  
9 Guam.

1           It is, therefore, the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to exempt OVIS fees  
2 collected by vehicle safety inspection stations on behalf of the government of Guam  
3 from being applied to gross income for the purpose of assessing and collecting  
4 business privilege taxes.

5           **Section 2.** § 3602(b)(1) of Article 6, Chapter 3, Title 16, Guam Code  
6 Annotated, is hereby *amended* to read:

7           “(b) (1) The fee to be charged for each such inspection *shall* be Fifteen  
8 Dollars (\$15.00), inclusive of the administrative fee (also known as the  
9 Official Vehicle Inspection Safety (OVIS) Fee), which *shall* be calculated at  
10 twenty percent (20%) of the current fee; provided, that the existing OVIS Fee  
11 of Three Dollars (\$3.00) *shall not* be adjusted below this amount. OVIS fees  
12 *shall not* be considered as a component of gross income for safety inspection  
13 stations for the purposes of assessing and collecting business privilege taxes.”

14           **Section 3.** A new § 26203(k)(37) is hereby *added* to Article 2 of Chapter  
15 26, Title 11, Guam Code Annotated, to read:

16           “(37) Official Vehicle Inspection Safety (OVIS) fees collected by safety  
17 inspection stations on behalf of the government of Guam under 16 GCA §  
18 3602(b)(1).”

19           **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Act *shall* become effective upon enactment.
