

AN ACT TO TRANSFER THREE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$300,000) FROM THE ANNUAL COMMUNITY CONTRIBUTION THE GUAM ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (GEDA) RECEIVES FROM THE GUAM HEALTHCARE DEVELOPMENT, INC., DBA GUAM REGIONAL MEDICAL CITY (GRMC) TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION FOR DEPOSIT IN THE HEALTHY FUTURES FUND; AND TO APPROPRIATE THREE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$300,000) TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF FUNDING THE CHILD PROTECTIVE SERVICES DIVISION AND PROGRAM.

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds
3 that the Guam Economic Development Authority (GEDA) Board of Directors
4 approved Resolution No. 13-062, recommending the issuance of a Qualifying
5 Certificate (QC) to Guam Healthcare Development, Inc., dba Guam Regional
6 Medical City (GRMC) based upon the findings set forth in Case Analysis Case No.
7 12-12-03 presented to the GEDA Board of Directors. Such recommendation

1 provided that tax abatements and rebates be approved, to include a corporate income
2 tax rebate at seventy-five percent (75%) for twenty (20) years, a corporate tax
3 dividend tax rebate at seventy-five percent (75%) for five (5) years, and a real
4 property tax abatement at one hundred percent (100%) for ten (10) years.

5 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* also finds that subject to such recommended approval
6 of the QC to GRMC, the Annual Community Contribution to be provided to the
7 government of Guam is as follows: Year 1: Five Hundred Thousand Dollars
8 (\$500,000); Year 2: Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000); Years 3 to
9 5: One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000); Years 6 to 10: One Million Two Hundred
10 Thousand Dollars (\$1,200,000); and Years 11 to 20: One Million Four Hundred
11 Thousand Dollars (\$1,400,000). Such funds were recommended to be allocated to
12 health care, public safety, economic development, higher education, and cultural
13 preservation.

14 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that for Fiscal Year 2019, the government
15 of Guam expects to receive One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) in Annual Community
16 Contributions from the GRMC; and *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* contends that such
17 Annual Community Contributions can be, and is, subject to legislative appropriation.

18 Therefore, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* intends to transfer such funds to the
19 Healthy Futures Fund in Fiscal Year 2019 for the purpose of funding the Child
20 Protective Services Division and Program pursuant to this Act; and it is also the
21 intent of *I Liheslaturan Guahan* to expand Child Protective Service response to
22 referrals and to expand active field work to ensure homeless children and other
23 children throughout the island are protected from physical abuse, provided adequate
24 shelter, and are able to avail services for their welfare.

25 **Section 2. Transfer of Funds from the Guam Economic Development**
26 **Authority to the Department of Administration.** Notwithstanding any other
27 provision of law, rule, or regulation, the sum of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars

1 (\$300,000) of the Annual Community Contribution from the Guam Healthcare
2 Development, Inc., dba Guam Regional Medical City received by the Guam
3 Economic Development Authority, from the effective date of this Act to September
4 30, 2019, *shall* be transferred from the Guam Economic Development Authority to
5 the Department of Administration within five (5) days of receipt of any portion or
6 portions received thereof. The Department of Administration *shall* deposit such
7 funds and record the revenue thereof into the Healthy Futures Fund, subject to
8 appropriation by *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* in the *General Appropriations Act of 2019*
9 and this Act.

10 **Section 3. Appropriation to the Department of Public Health and Social**
11 **Services for the Child Protective Services Division.** Notwithstanding any other
12 provision of law, rule, or regulation, the sum of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars
13 (\$300,000) is hereby appropriated from the Healthy Futures Fund in Fiscal Year
14 2019 to the Department of Public Health and Social Services for the sole purpose of
15 hiring additional Child Protective Services social workers, and funding training and
16 supplies, for the Child Protective Services Division and Program.

17 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Act *shall* become effective upon enactment.

18 **Section 5. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any
19 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity *shall*
20 *not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without
21 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are
22 severable.
