

**AN ACT TO *AMEND* § 9302 OF CHAPTER 9, ARTICLE 3,
TITLE 12, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO
THE ANNUAL DEPOSIT INTO THE GUAM VISITORS
BUREAU “*RAINY DAY FUND.*”**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. § 9302 of Chapter 9, Article 3, Title 12, Guam Code Annotated,
is *amended* to read:

“§ 9302. Annual Deposit.

An amount equal to one and one-half percent (1½%) of the adopted
revenue projection of the Tourist Attraction Fund for each fiscal year, or Two
Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000), whichever amount is greater, *shall* be
set aside and allocated by the Department of Administration to the Guam
Visitors Bureau for deposit into the Fund established by this Section. Each
annual deposit *shall* be made over the course of the fiscal year as collections
are received.”
