**AN ACT TO TRANSFER SEVEN HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$700,000) FROM THE ANNUAL COMMUNITY CONTRIBUTION THAT THE GUAM ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY RECEIVES FROM THE GUAM HEALTHCARE DEVELOPMENT, INC., DBA GUAM REGIONAL MEDICAL CITY, TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION FOR DEPOSIT INTO THE HEALTHY FUTURES FUND; AND TO APPROPRIATE SEVEN HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$700,000) TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES AS THE LOCAL MATCHING REQUIREMENT FOR THE MEDICAID PROGRAM.**

1           **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2           **Section 1. Transfer of Funds from the Guam Economic Development**  
3 **Authority to the Department of Administration.** Notwithstanding any other  
4 provision of law, rule or regulation, the sum of Seven Hundred Thousand Dollars  
5 **(\$700,000)** of the Annual Community Contribution from the Guam Healthcare  
6 Development, Inc., dba Guam Regional Medical City, received by the Guam  
7 Economic Development Authority by the effective date of this Act to September 30,  
8 2019 *shall* be transferred from the Guam Economic Development Authority to the  
9 Department of Administration within five (5) days of receipt of any portion or

1 portions received thereof. The Department of Administration *shall* deposit such  
2 funds into the Healthy Futures Fund and record the revenue thereof.

3 **Section 2. Appropriation to the Department of Public Health and Social**  
4 **Services for the Medicaid Program.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law,  
5 rule or regulation, the sum of Seven Hundred Thousand Dollars (**\$700,000**) is  
6 appropriated from the Healthy Futures Fund in Fiscal Year 2019 to the Department  
7 of Public Health and Social Services as the local matching requirement for the  
8 Medicaid Program.

9 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Act *shall* become effective upon enactment.

10 **Section 4. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any  
11 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity *shall*  
12 *not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without  
13 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are  
14 severable.
