AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THREE MILLION FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$3,500,000) FROM THE HEALTHY FUTURES FUND BALANCE, AS OF THE END OF FISCAL YEAR 2018, TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES AS THE LOCAL MATCHING REQUIREMENT FOR THE MEDICAID PROGRAM IN FISCAL YEAR 2019.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds
3 that Public Law 34-42, the General Appropriations Act of 2018, adopted a Healthy
4 Futures Fund (HFF) revenue estimate of Twenty-seven Million Eight Hundred
5 Sixty-two Thousand Six Hundred Ninety-five Dollars (\$27,862,695). According to
6 the Bureau of Budget and Management Research Special Revenue Fund Tracking
7 Report for the month ending September 30, 2018, Thirty-three Million Twenty-
8 seven Thousand One Hundred Forty-eight Dollars (\$33,027,148) in actual HFF
9 revenues were collected in Fiscal Year 2018. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds
10 that Public Law 34-124 appropriated One Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars
11 (\$1,500,000) from the unappropriated surplus in Fiscal Year 2018 HFF revenues for
12 Typhoon *Mangkhut*-related emergency purposes. Therefore, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*

1 intends to appropriate the unappropriated HFF revenues in excess of the adopted
2 HFF revenues to the Department of Public Health and Social Services for the sole
3 purpose of funding the local matching requirement of the Medicaid Program in
4 Fiscal Year 2019.

5 **Section 2. Appropriation to the Department of Public Health and Social**
6 **Services for the Medicaid Program.** Up to the sum of Three Million Five Hundred
7 Thousand Dollars (**\$3,500,000**) is appropriated from the Healthy Futures Fund fund
8 balance, as of the end of Fiscal Year 2018, to the Department of Public Health and
9 Social Services as the local matching requirement for the Medicaid Program in
10 Fiscal Year 2019. The appropriation in this Section *shall not* lapse and *shall* continue
11 until fully expended.

12 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Act *shall* become effective upon enactment.

13 **Section 4. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any
14 person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions
15 or applications of this Act that can be given effect without the invalid provision or
16 application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
