

**AN ACT TO TRANSFER ADMINISTRATIVE
JURISDICTION OF PORTIONS OF LOT NAVAL AIR
STATION AGAÑA 19 TO THE OFFICE OF THE MAYOR
OF *BARRIGADA* FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING
NEEDED RECREATIONAL FACILITIES.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Mina'Trentai Kuåttro Na*
3 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that the municipality of *Barrigada* desires to use and
4 maintain for public purposes Lot NAS *Agaña* 19, which was conveyed in perpetuity.
5 Furthermore, it is the understanding of the Office of the *Barrigada* Mayor that the
6 property *shall not* be sold, leased, assigned, or otherwise disposed of, and that the
7 Office of the *Barrigada* Mayor will continue to provide related recreational facilities
8 and services for various Guam sports organizations.

9 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that on March 7,1995, the *Barrigada*
10 Municipal Planning Council submitted its comments on the *Komitea Para Tiyan*
11 (KPT) NAS Reuse Master Plan. *Barrigada* presented an alternative course of action

1 for the KPT to review. The *Barrigada* Municipal Planning Council requested that
2 additional public lands be transferred to *Barrigada* so it can utilize said lands as
3 parks, and sports and recreation facilities.

4 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that *Barrigada* had even filed the
5 necessary documents known as “The Tiyan, Barrigada Foundation” to serve and
6 provide public benefits, education, and recreational services to our residents. This
7 approach was supported by the Office of the *Barrigada* Mayor and the *Barrigada*
8 Municipal Planning Council. The *Barrigada* position was based on the fact that the
9 community has proven experience in parks, sports and recreation facilities,
10 maintenance and management, and especially because *Barrigada* has no public
11 parks, recreation or sports facilities in its name.

12 **Section 2. Authorization to Transfer Lot Naval Air Station *Agaña* 19 to**
13 **the Office of the *Barrigada* Mayor.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law,
14 rule or regulation, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* authorizes *I Maga'låhen Guåhan* to
15 transfer existing recreational fields limited to the Tiyan Football Field, Tiyan
16 Maintenance Building, Tiyan Upper and Lower Softball Fields, and the land area
17 presently occupied by the carnival grounds within Lot Naval Air Station *Agaña* 19,
18 to the Office of the *Barrigada* Mayor, who *shall* assume administrative jurisdiction
19 over said portions of Lot Naval Air Station *Agaña* 19. The property *shall not* be sold,
20 leased, assigned, or otherwise disposed of, and the Office of the *Barrigada* Mayor
21 will continue to provide related recreational facilities and services for various Guam
22 sports organizations.

23 **Section 3. Reversionary Clause.** The Office of the *Barrigada* Mayor must
24 begin construction and refurbishment within five (5) years from the date of
25 enactment of this Act. In the event the property remains idle and the Office of the
26 *Barrigada* Mayor does not begin construction and refurbishment within the

1 stipulated time frame, administrative jurisdiction of the property *shall* revert to the
2 government of Guam.

3 **Section 4. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any
4 person or circumstance is found to be invalid, or contrary to law, such invalidity
5 *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect
6 without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
7 Act are severable.
