



II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

The public hearing was Called-to-Order at 2:03 PM.

Senator Chris Barnett, Chairman – Committee on Education, Public Safety, and the Arts: Håfa adai and good afternoon. This public hearing conducted by the Committee on Education, Public Safety and the Arts is called to order at 2:03 Chamorro Standard Time. Notice of the hearing was disseminated to all local media outlets on September 14, 2023 with the second notice provided on September 19th, 2023. Notice of the hearing was also made known on the Government of Guam Public Notices Portal and via radio ad. This afternoon, the committee is holding a public hearing to discuss the following appointments. The appointment of Margarita Felicitas B. Angel as the Guam Education Board Retired Teacher School Administrator of GDOE member of the Guam Education Board Fred E. Bordallo, Jr. as Director of Corrections, Lulene C. San Augustin as a Guidance Counselor Representative Member of the Guam Legislature Commission for Educator Certification, and Rosanna D. San Miguel Tiston as the General Public Representative Member of the Guam Academy Charter Schools Council.

I'd like to welcome my colleagues joining us today. To my right, the Vice Chair of the Committee on Education, Public Safety and the Arts, Senator Chris Duenas. And to my left, Senator Telo Taitague. Before we begin, I'd like to go over the general rules of conduct. Individuals testifying shall first be recognized by the Chair before speaking, shall state their name for record keeping purposes. I also want to thank Senator Jesse Lujan for joining us. Questions and testimony shall be confined to the substance or nature of the agenda, personal inference as to the character or motive of any senator, or individual testifying is not permitted, the chairperson of the committee may order the removal from the hearing any member of I Liheslaturan Guahan who fails to observe proper decorum pursuant to the 37th Guam Legislature's standing rules.

Any violation of this general rule of conduct will result in removal from the hearing by the host.

We now move on to the appointment of Lulene C. San Agustin as the Guidance Counselor Representative Member of the Guam Commission for Educator Certification.

And we'll go ahead and start with Miss Vangie Cepeda. Welcome back.

Evangeline Cepeda: Good afternoon. I'm back again. My name is Evangeline Cepeda. I'd like to thank this legislative body for being here and Senator Barnett, Senator Perez, Senator Taitague, and Senator Lujan for being present. I'm here today to support Lulene Concepcion San Agustin. For the record, she's family. She comes from a good family very much involved in the education field. I just, you know, I just think that this position, a lot of people don't, they're not aware of it. It's not a fun position. It's not an exciting position. It's not something that you're in the limelight. But at the end of the day, you're the person

in the back that makes. This things happen at the Department of Education. You know, it's very critical because you have to be with regards to reviewing things, making sure things the documentations are in order in regards to certification. It sometimes sucks at the end of the day. But somebody's gotta do it, and I'm glad that Lulene is stepping up to this and taking this position. And I'm here in full support of her. I don't want to prolong this. It's not a fun position. Nobody wants this position. Like they mentioned about deals, DLC now, but everyone's not knocking on the door. This is one of the cases of DOE that nobody wants to do. It's tedious, it's time consuming, it's very quiet, but she makes things happens to ensure that the teachers are in the classrooms to make sure that the teachers and counselors, guidance counselors are certified. And meet all the requirement under the 14 points of adequate education. I also want to mention that I'm glad that she's a guidance counselor representative member. It's very important. You know, when I was in the Board of Education, everybody emphasizes on the teachers. But we know in this society of ours, we have a mental crisis, anxiety, depression, suicide is extremely high here. Her, what she does day in and day out, I need to say is critical to our children. And I want to say that when I was going to school, when you say guidance counselor, it's okay, social studies, there, that's it. Really, that's what it was. Now, that's the bare minimum, because now they have to ensure that, is this child meeting their needs as far as, not educational, but mental. And they do the home front, you know, they take the extra mile that nobody really seems to care or know about. Because we emphasize on the teachers, which is, where it should be. It's Department of Education. But as you know, it takes a community to raise one child. And it's even harder today with the craziness. And I've said this before and I've said this again. Parents can't leave it to the schools. Parents should not leave it to the schools. And shame on those parents that do. I could not run for senator because they wouldn't vote for me because I'm saying the truth. But I need to say that parents need to own up to their children. In the old days, if I misbehave, my auntie Telo could come and tickle my ears, spank me, and my mom would not hesitate or interfere. Do it. I give you a second time to do it, if she does it again. So there was a commiunity effort. Here is a leave it to, guess who, the teachers, counselors, GPD, DOC. And it goes on and on. And so it's very critical that she takes this position. Not only is she working already as a counselor, but this is an added duty and responsibility. So, I'm here to say that I am in full support of Lulene with this position. And if nominated and passed, rest assured, you will not regret this. Thank you, Senators.

Chairman Barnett: Thank you, Mrs. Cepeda. And Roberta Abaday.

Ms. Roberta Abaday, Chairperson – Guam Commission for Educator Certification: Thank you, Senators, for allowing us to come today in support of Ms. San Agustin. My name is Roberta Abaday. I am the Chairperson for the Guam Commission for Educator Certification. As such, I am here as the representative, and I am telling you that we do need to have the representative for counseling. We are from the Department of Education, as well as from the community. We are always 100 percent in attendance at all of our meetings. Except for the last few months where we have been waiting for the representative to come for counseling. So we are looking forward to having her come on board with us, and we thank you very much for your positive nomination for her. Thank you.

Chairman Barnett: Thank you, ma'am. Ms. Lulene C. San Augustin, did you have a statement to make?

Ms. Lulene C. San Agustin, Nominee - Yes. Håfa Adai, Senator Barnett, Senator Lujan, Senator Perez, and Senator Taitague. I am honored to be here today as a nominated member of the Guam Commission of Educator Certification. I would also like to thank Governor Lou Leon Guerrero and Lieutenant Governor Joshua Tenorio for this appointment. Throughout my career, I have had the privilege of working in various capacities that have prepared me for this role. From my experience in working with now retired Judge Anita Sukola for 10 years in the courtroom, 6 years as a GDOE clinical intern under the supervision of Nadine Zepeda, and 11 years as a school counselor with the Guam Department of Education, I have gained valuable insights into the challenges of many of our children on Guam, children on Guam encounter. I know that having me on the committee and seeing me through the lens of a school counselor, together we can ensure that our educators not only imparts knowledge, but also fosters the social and emotional growth of our students. If confirmed, I pledge to approach my role as a commission member with dedication, integrity and a strong sense of responsibility. I believe in the power of collaboration and open communication to drive positive change. I am committed to working closely with my fellow commission members and making well informed decisions that serve the best interests of our children of Guam. In conclusion, I am truly excited about the opportunity to contribute to the success of the Guam Commission of Educator Certification. I am confident that we, together, we can achieve great things and uphold the mission for all students. Si Yu'os Ma'ase.

Chairman Barnett: Thank you, ma'am. You're definitely needed on the commission. So, we look forward to expeditiously moving your appointment. And I'll defer now to my colleagues starting with Senator Taitague.

Senator Telo T. Taitague: Thank you, Mr. Chair. Thank you so much, Ms. San Agustin, for stepping up to the plate serving, I mean, with your background. Oh my gosh, you know, anybody who would not confirm your appointment is really not well informed. But you have such a great background and that's what makes you even more special To give back to the community, especially when you have two ladies on the side giving a great support and these people are not Individuals that are not respected in the community themselves and for them to come up, you know and testify on your behalf says a lot I appreciate so I wish you the very best and I you have my support.

Ms. San Agustin: Thank you, Senator.

Chairman Barnett: Thank you, Senator Taitague. Senator Lujan.

Senator Jesse A. Lujan: Thank you, Mr. Chairman. Mr. Chairman, I've got no questions. You've got my full support.

Ms. San Agustin: Thank you. Thank you very much.

Senator Lujan: I think been said by both ladies sitting next to you, so I'm not even going to argue with that. Thank you. Thank you very much, Mr. Chair.

Chairman Barnett: Thank you, Senator. Senator Perez.

Senator Lujan: Thank you, Mr. Chair and it's great to see such support. I remember Mrs. Abaday. She used to be my instructor in education when I was getting my teacher degree. And just, you know, looking at your packet hearing you speak and your testimony. I think you're a high caliber candidate for this position, and I want to thank you for accepting this nomination. Thank you.

Ms. San Agustin: Thank you, I appreciate that. Thank you so much.

Chairman Barnett: Thank you, Senator Perez. Senator Quinata?

Senator Roy A.B. Quinata: First and foremost, I think we're related, but I think your mom is Miss Lou Benavente, right?

Ms. San Agustin: Yes, she is.

Senator Roy A.B. Quinata: Okay. So, yeah, we're definitely related. It's very good to see that you're stepping up to the public service table. You know, I see that you have an extensive career in the government, and you've also served in multiple capacities. So, not only because we're related am I gonna support you I wish you all the best and if my office can support you in any way, please let me know.

Ms. San Agustin: Thank you, Senator.

Senator Quinata: You got a lot of good supporters with you. Thank you.

Chairman Barnett: Thank you, Senator Quinata. Yeah, we know your mom, girl. I didn't put that in my opening speech. Nice. So, if there's no further testimony. Thank you. I appreciate it. Thank you for your testimony.
